ONTARIO RENOVATES PROGRAM NO LONGER ACCEPTING APPLICATIONS

Popularity of the *Ontario Renovates* Program for County of Renfrew Residents to Access Funding For Home Repairs, Results in Large Number of Applications

Renfrew, ON: The County of Renfrew, in partnership with the Province of Ontario, once again offered a program to assist homeowners to access funding for upgrades to their homes to enhance their quality of life. **Ontario Renovates** is a program that provides financial assistance to homeowners by way of a forgivable loan to repair their home to acceptable standards while improving the energy efficiency and/or increasing accessibility of their unit. Due to the overwhelming number of applications received, the Renfrew County Housing Corporation is no longer accepting applications to the program.
